## The Arc of Lane County Summer Work Program

Program dates: July 6 - August 28

The Arc of Lane County is offering a unique summer opportunity to individuals between 16-21 years old in the Eugene/Springfield and surrounding areas. The program is open to students who are interested in learning more about workplace readiness and experience an intellectual and/or developmental disability. Virtual lessons will be fun and engaging and help prepare participants to enter the workforce. We will be exploring topics such as, money management, digital citizenship, job applications, job interviews, teamwork, professionalism, and effective communication. Job exploration and work-based learning opportunities will be provided with virtual work place tours and job shadows. Classes will be 5 hours each week and held on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. On Wednesdays there will be the option to participate in 1 hour elective classes preparing participants to obtain an Oregon Driver's Permit and an Oregon Food Handler's permit.



### Technology

Classes will take place over Zoom and will utilize Google Classroom. They will be interactive and students will be able to talk live to a teacher.
