



# Supporting People with Disabilities Across Their Lifespan with Dynamic Programs





Helped 9 children whose parents are first responders meet Individualized Service Plan goals and supported them through distance learning.



Supported 6 youth whose parents are essential workers during distance learning and helped them reach goals.



Boosted morale for families with weekly summer Staycation Kits & monthly family fun activities. Led 10 parent trainings and provided IEP and behavior support/crisis intervention to numerous families.



Provides nearly 40 parents who are Spanish speaking and raising a child with a disability with peer support, and connection to resources. Delivered 3 virtual trainings and helped 4 families access formal service system.



The Arc's team of direct support professionals have helped nearly 75 families during the COVID pandemic, allowing parents and guardians to remain employed and individuals supported.

# 2020 Milestones



## EmployAbility

Helped 15 transition-age youth learn work readiness skills in virtual summer work program. Also, supported 10 individuals in keeping their employment during COVID and secured 5 new job placements.



## EmployAbility

Helped 7 individuals gain work experience by volunteering at the CARES Center, and secured volunteer opportunities at other sites as well. Created virtual classrooms to teach employment-based skills to adults with disabilities.



Despite building closure, staff continued to uplift spirits of participants via Zoom and telephone connection. Also, supported 16 adults in safely hiking, shopping in the community.

# 2020 Milestones



Raised \$70K at Play Your Part Virtual Auction in August. Scheduled to break ground on first phase of park in December with completion targeted for spring 2021.



Community Aligned Resources for Eugene and Springfield

Since opening in October, the CARES Center has provided 205 emergency food deliveries, provided food boxes to 1,538 households and supported 115 people either infected with or exposed to COVID.
